

# ATC Entrance, Tenancy and Graduation

## Eligibility criteria

ATC provides incubation and business services to companies creating marketable technologies in the areas of Health and Medical, ICT, Cleantech, Advanced Engineering, and Artificial Intelligence. A company must fulfill the following eligibility criteria for residency at ATC:

- Registered in Alberta or Canada;
- Has functional/demonstrable prototype(s) or product(s).

## Application process

Applications are accepted through an online form

(<https://advancedtechnologycentre.com/get-started/>). Screening and leasing of space to successful applicants takes about 12-15 business days. Applications are assessed based on the following merit-criteria:

- Alignment between applicant company's growth needs and ATC services;
- Significant innovation/competitive differentiation;
- Patented or protectable technology;
- Alignment between company's value proposition, market need/demand and business model;
- Potential for revenue generation and/or job creation;
- Companies with multi-product opportunity (vs. single-product companies);
- Product launched in foreign market(s) or has potential for export;
- Paying customer(s);
- Competent team;
- Capital for a minimum of one year;
- Technology's match with region's strengths (raw material, expertise, facilities, funding);
- Preference may be given to companies owned by women entrepreneurs/new immigrant-entrepreneurs (<3 years in Canada)/referred by organizations in ATC's network.
- Preference may be given to companies in business for 5 years or less
